I recently listened to their new CD "Mardi Blue Gras'' (produced at Silvox Studio Silvolde, Netherlands) and was quite impressed. One hears excellent musical treatments of traditional songs sung in both French and English. The band blends accordion, fiddle, guitar, bass, mandolin, banjo, percussion and vocals in their selections in a way that makes you want to play the album over and over again.
